

No marriage below the age of 15 years by 2021 The number of girls getting married between the age of 15 and 18 years will be reduced to one thirds by 2021



Recently repealed Child Marriage Restraint Act, 1929 failed to stop child marriage


1929 Vs 2017





Achievements




Bangladesh has improved its position from 5th highest child marriage country in 2013 to 8th in 2015



Reduced child marriage rate from66% of 2011 to 52% in 2015 and 35% in 2016



Reduced under 15 child marriage rate from 29% of 2011 to 18% in 2015 and 7% in2016


