









Prime Minister Fellowship At a glance

1. Introduction

Civil Service plays a key role in the formulation and implementation of public policies and is entrusted with, providing services to the citizens. Thus, it is contributing to the overall development of the country. Against this backdrop, a country always requires a competent Civil Service. In case of Bangladesh, the need for a knowledge-based and capable Civil Service is more important now than any time before, as we are approaching towards some significant milestones in 2026, 2030 and 2041. In this perspective, the government has emphasized on human resources development in all long-term planning documents. In line with that, the Prime Minister Fellowship (PMF) was introduced in 2018 by the Honourable Prime Minister in order to facilitate the capacity development of human resources across all sectors. Thereby, Governance Innovation Unit (GIU) is entrusted with the responsibility of the management of PMF.

2. Management of Prime Minister Fellowship

The Prime Minister Fellowship was introduced by the Honourable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in 2018 to develop knowledge-based and competent human resources. The program aims to create opportunities for higher studies (Master's degree and Ph.D.) abroad in different fields in order to develop skilled and efficient human resources. GIU at Prime Minister's Office was entrusted to manage the fellowship activities. The fellowship is awarded for pursuing Master degree and Ph.D. degree from foreign reputed universities.

The Fellowship is administered by two committees: the Fellowship Steering Committee and the Fellowship Selection Committee. The steering committee is headed by the Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister. Other members of the Steering Committee include representatives from the Ministry of Public Administration (MoPA), Finance Division (FD), Prime Minister's Office (PMO), and the representative from the University of Dhaka. The fellowship selection committee consists of the members of MoPA, FD, and a member from academia where the Director General, GIU is the head of the committee. It is important to mention that in addition to the selection committee, a subject matter expert also conducts the exam in PhD selection process. So far, 239 Masters fellows and 98 Ph.D. fellows have been awarded the scholarship to study at world-class universities.




Figure-1: Distribution of fellowships according to categories

Prime Minister Fellows study in many reputed universities in different countries including US, UK, Australia, and Canada. Under the fellowship program, a PhD fellowship is awarded only to the top 100 universities according to the Times Higher Education World University Ranking while for master's it is top 200. Consequently, Bangladeshi students are studying at global top-class universities such as Harvard University, Yale, Johns Hopkins University, and the University of California, US; the University of Oxford and the University of Cambridge, UK; and the Australian National University (ANU), Australia.




Figure-2: Number of fellows according to destination countries



Evaluation of the Prime Minister Fellowship Award

1. Introduction

As part of the overall human resource development initiative of the government, the Honourable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina introduced the Prime Minister Fellowship program in 2018 with a view to improving the knowledge and capacity of the civil service, academia, and the qualified citizen of Bangladesh and has given the responsibility to the Governance Innovation Unit (GIU) to administer and manage the fellowship. Under this fellowship program, the selected fellows are sent to different reputed foreign universities abroad including the USA, UK, Australia and Canada. Since the commencement of the program, about 239 Masters fellows and 98 PhD fellows have been sent to abroad to pursue their higher studies. A significant number of them have already returned to the country upon successful completion of their courses and have been employed in various sectors to serve the nation. To assess the impact of the program, no rigorous evaluation of the program has yet been conducted. But a short evaluation has been carried out with the fellows who have already returned to Bangladesh till 2022. The questionnaire was distributed to the master degree fellows who returned to Bangladesh after completing their program. As many as 66 fellows responded and the report is based on the evaluation of 66 fellows.


The evaluation study was done to assess the perception of the fellows about their professional development and their social experiences abroad. The fellows were surveyed with a set of questionnaires and provided their answers in a five-point Likert scale. Then the answers were analyzed and presented graphically. The theoretical basis of the evaluation was based on the four-level Kirkpatrick Model. It assesses any training and educational programs against four level of criteria i) Reaction, ii) Learning, iii) Behavior and iv) Results. Learning and Reaction levels were basically evaluated based on the perception of the participants through interviews and Behavior, while Results levels were evaluated based on the behavioral change analysis and performance evaluation of individual participants.

The findings of the study were encouraging. In relation to personal and professional development, as well as social experience with other students and the local communities all fellows have shown their positive achievement in all respects. The aggregated key findings are shown below:






Social Experience with other students and the local communities



2. The role of fellowship in higher education

The scholarship proved to be instrumental in empowering and facilitating the recipients in their pursuit of higher education. According to the study, it was observed that an overwhelming majority, approximately 90.9 percent, of the respondents recognized and appreciated the scholarship and also contribution to their educational endeavors. This recognition underscores the profound influence that the scholarship had on their ability to achieve higher education and unlock future opportunities.

3. Conclusions

The GIU designed an assessment questionnaire with both closed and open questions to understand how fellows responded to the fellowship program and how they perceive the role of fellowship in capacity building. Although the effectiveness of the fellowship program can only be evaluated in a sustained way after a few years, the perceptions of fellows are an important parameter for assessing their feeling about the program. This assessment also provides a pathway for further in-depth assessment of the program. The findings suggest that the Prime Minister Fellowship Programme was extremely well received by the participants, contributing to the improvement of their knowledge and skills and the exchange of experiences on the subject.

The fellowship programme was, in general, extremely well-valued by all participants, which manifested in the evaluation questionnaires. They particularly highlighted the initiative and the improvement of their knowledge and skills such as critical thinking, research capability, problem-solving, and communication skills.

PM fellowship is considered as the most prestigious fellowship program in Bangladesh. It plays a significant role in fostering skilled public administrators and academicians. This fellowship program focuses on aligning with the development agenda of Bangladesh as well as fostering good governance and public services. The initial assessment shows valuable insights for further improvement. The findings highlighted the program's positive aspects, such as adequate funding, efficient financial management, and a transparent selection process. This is the first endeavour of the evaluation process in which only the immediate reaction is reflected. The analysis also could not take the response of all fellows. The process is a continuous one and will add all fellows in the next step of evaluation. In the next stage, along with the reaction level which includes all master degree fellows, the learning will be evaluated according to the theoretical underpinning.
